SPRING Checklist [

Ok guys. Here it is - My COMPLETE AND TOTAL checklist for spring cleaning. Seriously, it's all here. Print these pages out, and use them as a check list, or just pick the most important areas for you! Trust me, when I start deeeeeeep cleaning, having a list helps maintain my sanity, and save me from reaching for a toothbrush to clean every dark, dusty corner.

KITCHEN

- O Remove and put away all visible clutter
- O Clear cobwebs from ceiling and corners
- Wipe down any doors, including frame, trim, threshold, and knobs
- Wipe down baseboards, light features, light switches and outlet covers
- Replace any necessary light bulbs
- Wash windows, window sills, tracks, and frames
- Wash window coverings
- Clean and organize your pantry and cabinets.
 Sort items to purge, store or keep before returning to cabinets. Consider facing all labels forward for easy product locating
- Wipe down the outside of cabinets to remove grease and grime, disinfecting handles
- Clean and organize fridge and freezer Throw away anything that's expired (duh) and be honest with yourself about what condiments you will actually use again
- Dust off top of fridge and cabinets
- O Disinfect handles of fridge
- Move large appliances and clean behind them and the sides, including fridge coils
- Clean out vents on the backs of large appliance (make sure that are switched off)
- Clean all small appliances, including coffee maker, toaster, mixer, processor, etc.
- O Clean the microwave Inside and out

- Assess kitchen gadgets and tools Anything you don't use, donate!
- Give all pots and pans a good wipe, and re-organize in cabinets or drawers with matching lids if necessary. If you have cast iron, consider re-seasoning
- Run the self-cleaning option on the oven or clean yourself, paying attention to the outside as well, removing nobs. Remove and clean drip pans
- Clean overhead exhaust and replace filter, if necessary
- Clean counter, backsplash and all over surfaces (tables, island, buffet, chairs, stools, etc.)
- O Deep clean sink, drains and faucet
- Remove all items from under the sink and clean cabinet. Sort to get rid of unnecessary items before returning. Be sure to launder any used dust rags
- Deep clean dishwasher by running a heavy cleaning cycle with a bowl with 1 cup of vinegar on the bottom rack
- O Clean and deodorize garage can
- Empty any missed junk drawers. Clean the interior and sort through items to keep, store or discard
- Vacuum any vents
- Launder and shake out any rugs
- Sweep, mop and vacuum floor

DINING ROOM

- Remove and put away all visible clutter
- Remove and put away any irrelevant seasonal décor
- Clear cobwebs from ceiling and corners
- Dust and wash light fixtures
- Replace any necessary light bulbs
- Clean light switch plates and outlet covers
- Wipe down any doors, including frame, trim, threshold, and knobs
- Dust and clean any picture frames or wall décor
- Remove all items from shelves. Dust or wash each item and the shelf before returning
- Wipe down walls
- O Clean windows, window sills, tracks, and frames
- O Dust and clean all surfaces, such as tables, buffet, etc.

- Remove all items from china cabinet. Clean interior. Clean each item from china cabinet before returning. Store or discard any unnecessary items
- Launder table linens

- Wipe down all seat frames, top to bottom
- Empty any missed junk drawers. Clean the interior and sort through items to keep, store, or discard
- Vacuum any vents
- Wipe baseboards and any other trim
- Launder or shake out any rugs
- Sweep, mob and/or vacuum

1 cup borax

1 cup table salt

20 drops lavender essential oil

10 drops tea tree essential oil

Approx 1 cup water

Spritz the mixture until it feels like slightly wet (not too wet) sand.

Press into silicone cookie molds or ice cube trays. Allow the bombs to dry completely before pressing out of the molds. Store in a mason jar with a pretty label.

TO USE: Toss a bomb into the toilet BEFORE YOU GO (particularly #2). This way there will be zero odor.
